Page 1	Change of date to March 26, 2022
Page 2	4C. Adds requirement that BCCC members must be continuously registered as a Republican for six months prior to election or appointment
	4D. Requires BCCC to meet at least quarterly
	4E. Requires BCCC membership to be reviewed at each BCCC meeting and requires the issue to be on the agenda.
	5B. Limits activities of Ward Officers, specifically Ward Officers may not endorse in a primary or serve as campaign staff, managers, or consultants.
Page 3	5C4. Adds missing word "person"
	6C. Defines terms of County Executive Committee members.
Page 4	8B. Changed italics to regular font.
	8C. Changed italics to regular font AND defined the term "Good standing".
	9A. Specifies that Ward Chairs actively identify Ward members to fill vacancies on BCCC.
	9B. Specifies that vacancies to SCC vacancies be filled by Wards where vacancy occurs.
	10. Addresses responsibility of BCCC members to financially support RPBC.
Page 5	11. New section "operating procedures" enables documentation or procedures that can and should transition from one administration to the next.
